Mira performed with the Lexington High School Chamber Singers as a guest soloist at the 2022 Boston ACDA Conference. She also placed first in the 2022 Regional NATS Competition.

Marilyn Swinger is a freshman at Vanderbilt University studying Human & Organizational Development and Music, where she is currently under the tutelage of Molly Barth, Grammy award winner and Professor of Flute at Vanderbilt's Blair School of Music. This March, Marilyn gave a solo performance at Blair's Turner Hall, and in February she traveled as a member of the Blair School's Wind Ensemble to Athens, Georgia, to attend the National Conference of the College Band Directors National Association. In 2022 she was the Lexington High School's Haas Memorial Concerto Competition winner, the first chair flute at the MMEA All-State Orchestra, and a member of the Youth Philharmonic Orchestra at the New England Conservatory. In 2021 she was invited to play in the NAfME All-Eastern Band. And in 2020 she was a guest soloist for the Lexington Symphony Orchestra's "On Stage, At Home" series. For nine years before college, Marilyn was a student in Jessica Lizak's flute studio.
